

## ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

<b>C</b>		<b>Back Leg</b>	2

## HARDWARE

<b>D</b>		<b>Metal Gasket</b>	12
<b>E</b>		<b>Spring Washer</b>	12
<b>F</b>		<b>Screw(M8*60)</b>	12
<b>G</b>		<b>Wrench</b>	1

### BEFORE BEGINNING ASSEMBLY:



*Read instructions cover to cover*



*Have two adults on hand for assembly*



*Do NOT assemble on flooring or carpet. Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (ex: packing foam)*



*Save all packaging until assembly is completed*



## ASSEMBLY STEPS

---


### STEP 1



- › Position the product on its bottom as shown.
- › Open to take the four legs.

---

### STEP 2



- › Position 1 leg (C) in the wooden frame as shown. Insert 2 screws (F), washers (E) and gaskets (D) into the pre-drilled holes to attach the leg.
- › Use wrench (G) to tighten the screws (F) clockwise - do not fully tighten at this point.
- › Repeat this process for the other 3 legs.

### **STEP3**



› Turn the chair upright to ensure all four legs are even and level. Once done, screws can be fully tightened.

Assembly is now complete.

## CARE & MAINTENANCE



**Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.**



**Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.**



**Dust and pick up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.**



**Stains may be removed with a mild soap solution and a damp cloth.**



**Do not place furniture under direct sunlight.**



**Do not place furniture near heating or cooling vents.**



**Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.**



**Do not place furniture outside, for indoor use only.**
